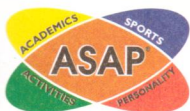

Sub: Recognition certificate for the school under sub-rule (4) of rule 11 of right of Children to free and Compulsory Education rules, 2011 for the purpose of section 18 of Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education act,2009.

Dear Sir/Madam,

With reference to your application dated 2019 and subsequent correspondence with the school/ inspection in this regard, I convey the grant of provisional recognition **MAYOR WORLD SCHOOL, URBAN ESTATE PHASE-I, JALANDHAR** for the Class 1ST TO 8th for a period i.e 01.09.2021 TILL 31.03.2024.

The above sanction is subject to the fulfillment of the following condition, namely: -

1. The grant for recognition is not extendable and does not in any imply any obligation to recognize/affiliate beyond class VIII.
2. The school shall abide by the provision of the Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009 (Annexure I) and the Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Rules, 2011 (Annexure II)
3. The school shall admit in class 1, to the extent of 25% of the strength of that class, children belonging to the weaker section and the disadvantaged group in the neighborhood and provide free and compulsory elementary education till its completion:
Provided, that in case of pre-primary classes also, this norm shall be followed.
4. For the children referred to in paragraph 3, the school shall be reimbursed as a per sub-section 2 of section 12 of the Act. To receive such reimbursement, the school shall provide a separate bank account.
5. The school shall not collect any capitation fee and subject the child or his or her parents or guardians to any Screening Procedure.
6. The school shall not deny admission:
 - a) To any child for lack of age proof; or
 - b) If such admission is sought subsequent to the extended period prescribed period prescribed for admission; or
 - c) On the ground of religion, caste or race, place of birth or any of these reasons.
7. The school shall ensure that: -
 - a) no child admitted, shall be held back in any class or expelled from school till the completion of elementary Education in a school;
 - b) no child shall be subjected to physical punishment or mental harassment;
 - c) no child is required to pass any board examination till the completion of elementary education;
 - d) every child completing elementary education shall be awarded a certificate as laid down under rule 21;
 - e) inclusion of students with disabilities/ special needs as per the provision of the Act;
 - f) the teachers are recruited with minimum qualifications, as laid under sub- section (1) of section 23; provided that the existing teachers who, at the time of commencement of the Act, do not posses the minimum qualifications, shall acquire such qualifications with in a period of 5 years from the date of commencement of the Act. (Which has been extended up to 31.03.2019 as per amendment in RTE Act 2009.)
