


10 DAY UK TOUR FOR LAWRENCE SCHOOL SANAWAR STUDENTS



THE LAWRENCE SCHOOL, SANAWAR : AUSTRALIA CRICKET TOUR (December 2025)

The Lawrence School, Sanawar Junior Cricket Team undertook a highly enriching and memorable cricket tour to Australia from 14th to 25th December 2025. The tour itinerary was meticulously organised to create a balanced blend of **competitive sport, experiential** and **intercultural learning, leadership development, and essential life skills** such as time management, decision-making, and independence. Each day was carefully structured to maximise learning opportunities both on and off the field.

The journey commenced from **New Delhi on 14 December**, with travel via **Singapore to Sydney**, followed by a transfer to **Canberra**. Despite long travel hours and tight schedules, the students displayed discipline, adaptability, and teamwork from the very beginning. Canberra served as the initial base, where the team played its opening matches against **St Edmund's College**. These matches exposed players to Australian playing conditions, faster pitches, and disciplined team strategies, strengthening **resilience** and **tactical understanding**.

A major highlight in Canberra was the visit to the

Australian Institute of Sport (AIS), where students gained valuable insights into elite training methodologies, sports science, fitness planning, and professional athlete discipline. Academic and civic learning was further enriched through visits to the **Australian Parliament**, the **National War Memorial** - where the team respectfully attended the Last Post Ceremony - and the **Indian High Commission**, fostering historical awareness, civic responsibility, and national pride. The visit to **Questacon**, the National Science and Technology Centre, encouraged curiosity and innovation through hands-on scientific exhibits.

The tour progressed to Sydney, where the team competed against reputed local clubs including Normanhurst Cricket Club, Bankstown Cricket Club, and Inner West Harbour Cricket Association. These matches challenged the players' skills while reinforcing **leadership, teamwork, communication, and sportsmanship**. Playing alongside and against students from diverse backgrounds - including girls - helped break social barriers, build **confidence, and promote inclusivity** in a global sporting environment.

An important life skill developed throughout the tour was learning to navigate Australia's efficient public transport system. Students independently used buses, trains, metros, and trams across Canberra, Sydney, and the Gold Coast, gaining practical knowledge of routes, schedules, ticketing systems, and time coordination - an **invaluable lesson in responsibility and real-world problem-solving**.

Cultural exposure was further enhanced through visits to iconic landmarks such as the **Sydney Opera House**, **State Library of New South Wales**, **Royal Botanic Gardens**, and **Olympic Park**. Attending a live **Big Bash League** match at **ENGIE Stadium** provided insight into professional sporting culture, crowd management, and stadium protocols.

The Gold Coast leg offered a blend of recreation and learning. Visits to **Warner Bros. Movie World** and **Wet'n'Wild** required effective time management and decision-making due to festive crowds. The students also experienced Australia's **culinary diversity**, enjoying a wide range of international cuisines, including local Australian fare, Turkish, Asian and multi-cultural street dining, broadening their **cultural appreciation through food**.



CANCELLATION POLICY

- **BOOKING CONFIRMATION (> 60 DAYS BEFORE DEPARTURE): A 25% DEPOSIT OF THE TOTAL LAND PACKAGE COST TO SECURE FLIGHTS, HOTELS, AND VISA FEES IS NON-REFUNDABLE AND NON-TRANSFERABLE, TO COVER UPFRONT ADMINISTRATIVE COSTS AND SUPPLIER COMMITMENTS.**
- **BETWEEN 45 AND 59 DAYS BEFORE DEPARTURE: A CANCELLATION CHARGE OF 50%**
- **BETWEEN 30 AND 44 DAYS BEFORE DEPARTURE: A CANCELLATION CHARGE OF 75%**
- **LESS THAN 30 DAYS BEFORE DEPARTURE: 100% CANCELLATION CHARGE, MEANING YOU WILL NOT GET ANY REFUND.**
- **DURING THE TOUR: IF YOU CUT YOUR TRIP SHORT, THERE WILL BE NO REFUND FOR UNUSED SERVICES.**

NOTE: ALL CANCELLATIONS MUST BE VIA E-MAIL ONLY. IT WOULD TAKE AT LEAST 45 DAYS TO PROCESS THE REFUND (IF DUE).

THE ORGANISER RESERVES THE RIGHT TO RESCHEDULE THE DATE IN CASE OF ANY UNFORESEEN CALAMITY OR UNAVOIDABLE CIRCUMSTANCES.

High School International Sports Tour: Booking & Cancellation Policy

Organising an international youth sports tour is like laying the foundation for a successful season—it requires early commitment, precise coordination, and absolute teamwork. Long before our student-athletes step onto the pitch, we are securing tournament registrations, hiring international grounds, confirming local fixtures, and blocking group flights and youth-appropriate accommodations.

Because these logistical pillars require significant, non-refundable upfront payments, we have designed a policy that protects the integrity of the tour while offering fair, transparent guidelines for parents and schools.

1. Securing the Roster (The Deposit)

- **25% of the Total Tour Cost** is required to confirm the student's spot on the roster.
- **Status:** Non-refundable and non-transferable to other dates.
- *Why?* This initial deposit goes immediately toward hard costs: tournament entry fees, booking international sports facilities, securing group flight blocks, and initiating the visa group application process.

2. Standard Cancellation Schedule

If a student must withdraw from the tour, the following charges will apply based on the date we receive written notice from the parent or school coordinator:

- **More than 60 days before departure:** * **Cancellation Charge:** 25% (Loss of deposit only).
 - *Fairness Note:* We encourage early sign-ups to build the team. If family plans change well in advance, you will only forfeit the initial deposit. No further penalties apply.
- **Between 45 and 59 days before departure:**
 - **Cancellation Charge:** 50% of the total tour cost.
 - *Reasoning:* At this stage, we finalise our team numbers with international host schools/clubs, lock in our transport coaches (which are sized based on headcounts), and international hotels enforce their strict cancellation penalties for our group block.
- **Between 30 and 44 days before departure:**
 - **Cancellation Charge:** 75% of the total tour cost.
 - *Reasoning:* Flights are fully ticketed, rooming lists are locked, and tournament brackets are officially finalised based on our exact squad size.
- **Less than 30 days before departure (or No-Show):**
 - **Cancellation Charge:** 100% of the total tour cost.
 - *Reasoning:* A late withdrawal impacts the entire team's ability to compete. Furthermore, due to the complex timeline of processing international visas for minors from India, it is impossible for us to onboard a replacement student this

close to departure.

3. Flexibility & Fairness Clauses

We understand that teenage life is unpredictable. To support our families, we offer the following exceptions:

A. Student Player Substitutions (Name Changes) If a student is unable to travel, the school or parent may transfer the booking to another eligible student up to **60 days prior to departure**, provided the replacement student has sufficient time to secure the required visa.

- *Cost:* You will only be charged a standard administrative fee (e.g., ₹5,000) plus any actual name-change fees imposed by the airlines. This keeps the team squad full and minimises financial loss for the family.

B. Visa Rejection We assist with rigorous visa preparation, but final decisions rest with the embassy. If a student's visa is formally rejected despite submitting all required, accurate documents (including mandatory parental No Objection Certificates) on time:

- You will be refunded the tour cost *minus* the 25% non-refundable deposit and any actual visa application fees incurred.
- *Note:* This does not apply if the rejection is due to late document submission or incomplete parental consent forms.

C. Fixture Adjustments International youth sports rely on the goodwill of host clubs and schools. If a specific local team cancels a friendly match, we guarantee a replacement fixture or an equivalent training session with local coaches. Because the core value of the tour (travel, accommodation, training, and team building) remains intact, fixture adjustments do not qualify for partial refunds.
