3. **Morning Yoga and Exercises:** The most important daily routine for a healthy life.

5. **Medical:** Facilities for the basic medical aid will be available at camp site; however those on special medication or with known drug allergies are advised to bring their necessary medicines.
6. **Safety:** Complete emphasis is on use of superior quality imported adventure equipment and trained instructors to ensure safety of the students. Students should to ensure not to carry sharp things like nail cutter, knives, blade, scissors, safety pins, needles etc.


Camp Cost : ₹1350/- (Thirteen Hundred and Fifty only) per student, includes accommodation in Alpine Tents, Activities, Adventure Equipments, Meals, Fruits, Snacks, Trained Instructors etc.

- Children are required to report strictly according to the given time and be in their track suits and NOT in their school uniform.
- All parents are requested to drop their children to School on **17th March 2026, Tuesday. at 4.00 p.m.** Buses will not ply
- The list of articles to be brought to School is given below. No cash, valuables, mobile phones or cameras are to be brought by the children.
- Parents are requested not to come to School to check on their children anytime during the camp hours. In case of any need, the school will get in touch with the parents.
- Those on special medication or with known drug allergies, are advised to bring the necessary medicines and hand them over to the teacher in-charge.
- Parents are requested to pick up their wards from the school on **18th March, 2026, Wednesday at 08:00 am** after the breakfast. **Buses will not ply.**
